



Hotel Standards Condition Assessment

The purpose of the condition assessment is to enable objective and accurate condition reporting of hotel assets.

Through the assessment ranking process, assets will be regularly assessed throughout their product lifecycle ensuring they not only meet the needs of our guests but are maintained to brand standard. Assigning condition ranks (1-5) will be used to assess at individual asset level as well as aggregating up to deliver a venue score.

The payoff in using the condition assessment tool will ensure transparency at multi-level ship condition, enabling suitable responses at operational levels as well as long term capital forecasting.



1 - New

Looks new; just onboarded, installed, or recently refurbished to a good condition.



2 - Minimal Use

Minor wear and tear; only close inspection will reveal signs of slight wear such as minor scuffs, slight pilling or small stains that can be fixed.



3 - Moderate Use

The asset is fairly worn and shows more noticeable signs of wear.

This can include scratches, dents, discolouration and scuffs.



4 - Major Use

The asset has the potential to be brand damaging with signs of extensive use such as chipped framework, snags in upholstery, and threadbare seams.



5 - HESS

The asset is damaged beyond repair; this could develop into a HESS hazard and must be removed from service.
