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LOOK THE PART

As a new to sea Officer or Crew member, here are a few handy hints to help you **Navigate** your way.



The company provides uniform when you first join.



P&O Cruises requires all uniformed crew to take all good and wearable condition uniform (including shoes) home when disembarking at the end of a tour of duty.



Our Global Talent Partners and Onboarding Team will set you up on one of our ordering portals for uniform.



Uniforms are provided, but does not include the following for Officers so,

You Must Bring Your Own:

Underwear

For white uniforms, neutral coloured underwear is recommended.

Appropriate underwear must be worn at all times and not visible through your uniform.

Socks

Socks must be plain with no logos/designs. White socks must be worn with white footwear. Black socks must be worn with black footwear.

Hosiery

Hosiery is available to buy onboard, but sizes and styles are very limited so bring these with you. Tights or hold-ups are required to be worn when wearing a uniform dress or skirt at all times of the day and must not exceed 40 deniers.

The colour of hosiery must be in keeping with the color of the uniform.

Patterned or seamed hosiery is not permitted. For an Officer wearing Tropical Whites', hosiery is optional.

Shoes

Officers are NOT issued footwear as part of their standard allocation, so you will need to provide your own Safety Shoes if required for your role, WILL be provided.





OFFICER UNIFORM



Officers place their orders via the Incorporate Wear Portal (ICW).



The Global Talent Partners (GTP) or Onboarding Team will have set you up on the ICW prior to you joining and a link will be sent to your personal e-mail address



When you log on, you will be able to see the images of the uniform and what you can order.



The uniform for Officers' consists of three basic styles and are worn at different times of day or on Formall Nights, these are known as the "Rig of the Day"



A standard Officer uniform allocation consists of:

Blues & 12A



Blues Jacket x 1 Blues/12A trousers or skirts x 3 12A shirt or blouse x 3 Black Tie x 1 Black Belt x 1

Tropical Whites



Tropical white shirt or blouse x 3
Tropical white trousers or skirts x 3
White canvas belt x 1

Formal Mess Kit



Formal Mess Jacket x 1
Formal Mess trouser or skirt x 1
Formal Mess shirt or female fit top x 2
Bow Tie x 1
Cummerbund x 1



CREW UNIFORM

As a new to sea Crew member, here are a few handy hints to help you **Navigate** your way.



Crew uniform is placed via the Control Cloud portal and is done by your Head of Department (HOD).



Our Global Talent Partners (GTP) or Onboarding Team will have set you up on the Control Cloud portal, prior to you joining.



The GTP or Onboarding team will have added your sizes which generates an e-mail to your HOD, informing them of your embarkation date, sizes and job role, so the uniform can be ordered prior to you joining.



You will be able to collect the uniform when you join the ship and any exchanges for sizing can be processed by the Head of Department. A standard allocation of uniform will vary depending on the role you are in, but as a stadard, usually consists of:

Trousers x 3 Shirts/Blouses x 3 Footwear x 1 Belt x 1
